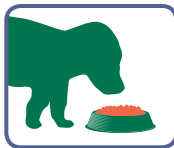

Tailor-made for Chihuahuas over 8 months of age.

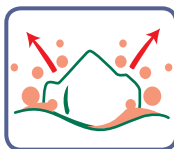
Healthy Heart

The Chihuahua can live longer than 15 years. After age 10 the small dogs are traditionally troubled by degenerative diseases: periodontal disease, sclerosis of the heart valves, chronic kidney failure and cataracts. Cardio-respiratory pathologies are much more common in the Chihuahua than in other breeds. L-carnitine (200 mg/kg), Taurine, Arginine, moderate Sodium levels, Green Tea Polyphenols, Vitamins E (600 mg/kg) & C (300 mg/kg) help to strengthen the heart.



Stimulates Delicate Appetite

The Chihuahua must be fed a food that takes into account its actual needs. If the dog is not exposed to a diverse diet it will rarely refuse to eat a food, provided the palatability is satisfactory. The diet for a small dog needs to have more flavour because its sense of smell is less acute than that of a large dog. The small surface area of the olfactory mucus means there are fewer olfactory receptor cells. A selection of highly palatable ingredients, with exclusive aromas help to stimulate the Chihuahua's finicky appetite.



Reduces Tartar

Chihuahua's are prone to sensitive teeth and gums. This sensitivity is linked to deposits of tartar. A Chihuahua's diet must take this into account in order to improve oral hygiene and prevent future teeth and gum problems. Sodium Tripolyphosphate, Green Tea Polyphenols, and unique kibble shape, size, density & texture effectively 'brush' the teeth to help prevent the build-up of plaque and tartar.



Reduces Stool Odour

The Chihuahua is the ideal indoor dog and it often lives in apartments - it may even use a litterbox. Although they may produce only a small amount of feces, it is important to limit unpleasant odors caused by this type of lifestyle. Highly digestible proteins (Soy Protein Isolate), Brown Rice, Beet Pulp, Pea Fiber, Zeolite and FOS* help to limit unpleasant stool odour & quantity.
